NOTES: Mandatory city water hookup - all property owners/developers, requesting development approval, shall be required to connect to the city's public water system, consistent with the standards listed in section 115-6.1

No new landscape irrigation wells constructed within the city. The city manager or his/her designee may grant an exception by permit for well, potable water, or storm water use for irrigation a limited duration where the city's reclaimed/reuse water is not available for landscape irrigation or bona fide agricultural uses. Such permit's duration, however, shall not exceed the time when the city's reclaimed/reuse service is available.
