NOTES: Every principal use in the city and every lot in a subdivision shall be served by a water supply system that is adequate to accommodate the reasonable needs of such use or subdivision lot and that complies with all applicable health regulations. All residential, commercial or industrial developments within the city must connect to the central water system (Southern States Utilities) and have a city fire hydrant located within 400 feet of the building unless specifically permitted by the city council to do otherwise.
