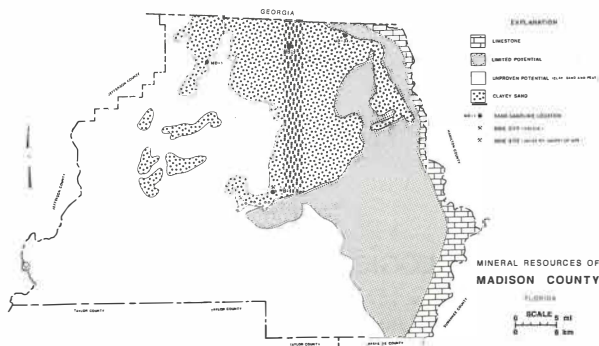

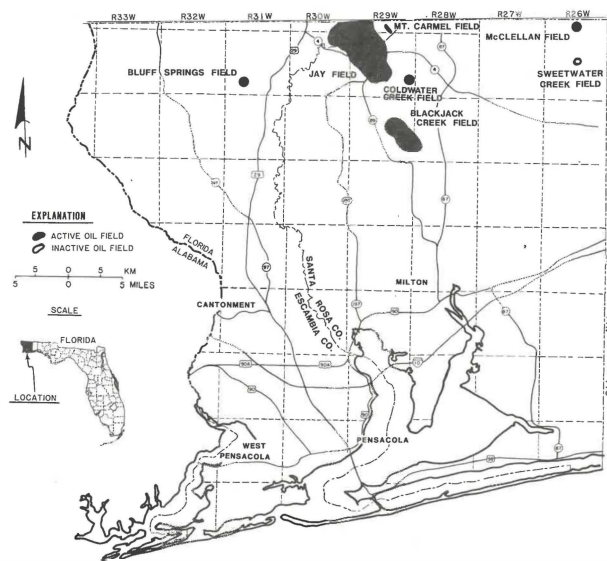

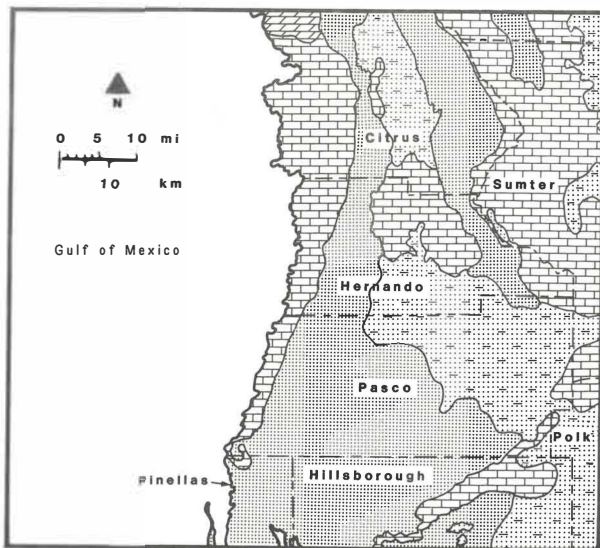
NORTH FLORIDA OIL FIELD LOCATION MAP
