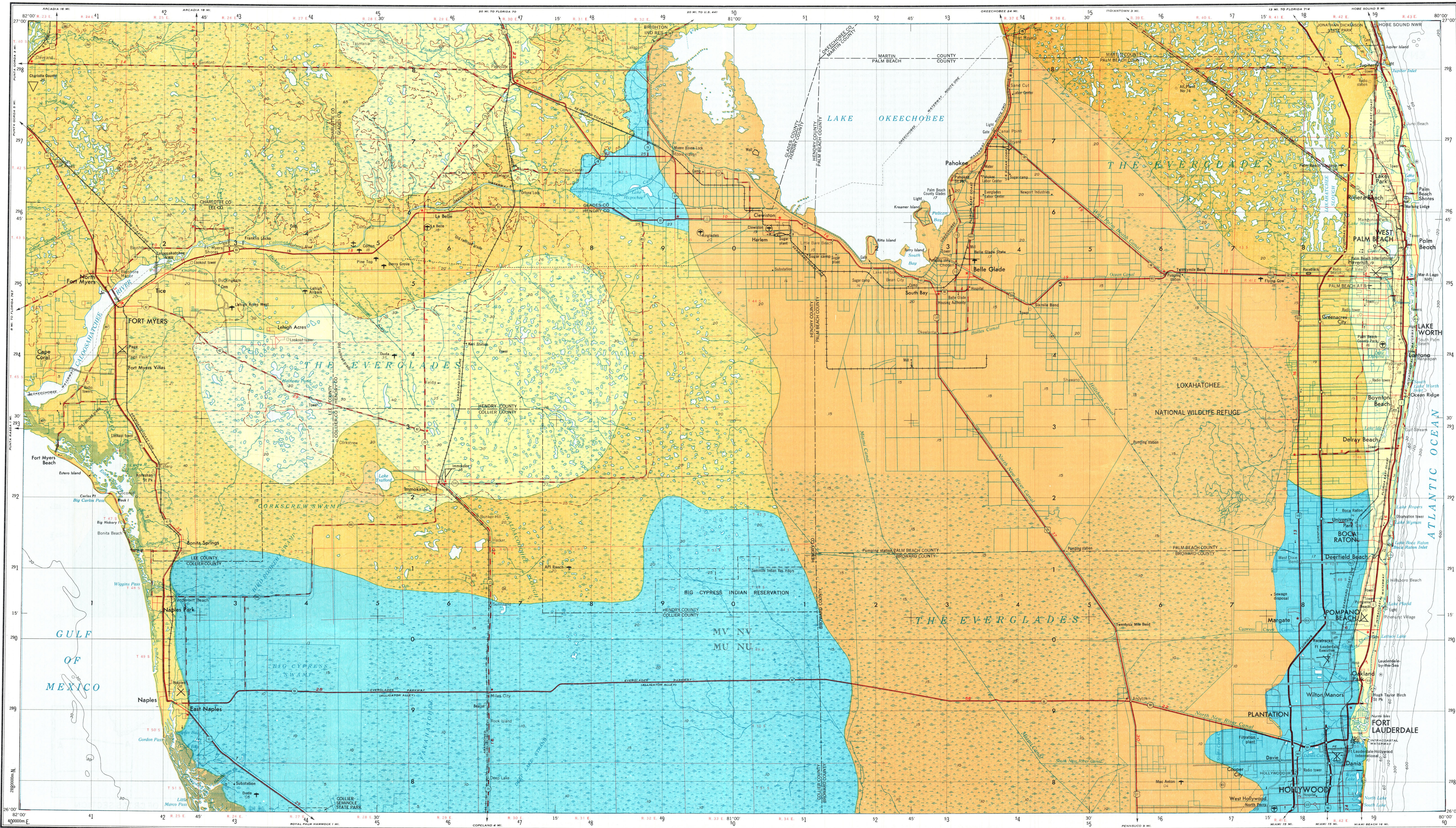
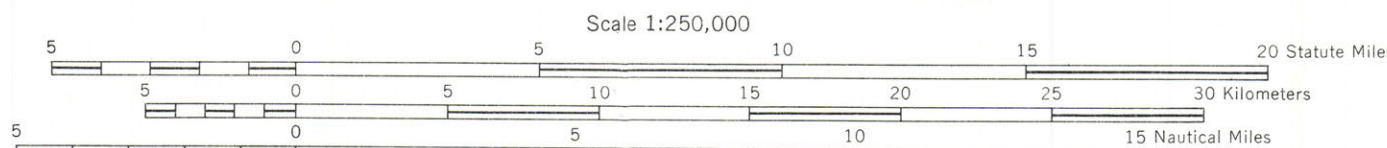




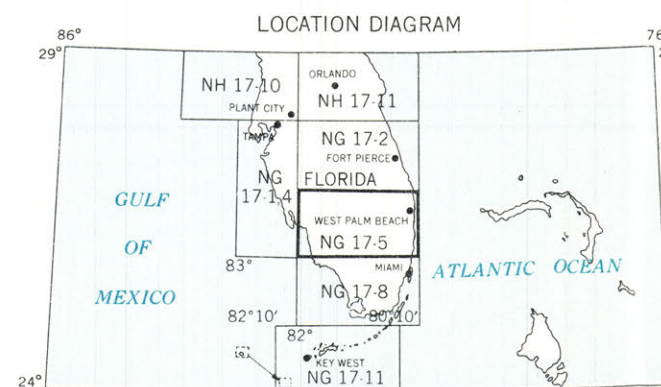
Each area outlined on this map may consist of more than one kind of sub-surface sediment. The map is thus meant for general planning rather than a basis for decisions on the use of specific tracts.

TO GIVE A STANDARD REFERENCE TO TWO SHEETS TO NEAREST 1000 METERS

SAMPLE POINT: FIELD

1. Read letters identifying 100,000 meter square in which the point lies.

2. Locate first VERTICAL and line to LEFT of point and read LARGE figure labeling the line either in the top or bottom margin, or on the line itself.

3. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.

4. Locate first HORIZONTAL and line BELOW point and read LARGE figure labeling the line either in the left or right margin, or on the line itself.

5. Estimate tenths from grid line to point.

6. If reporting beyond 10' in any direction, prefix Grid Zone Designation, as:
