Subject: Department approval of the Mosquito Lagoon Reasonable Assurance Plan and amendments to the Verified List of Impaired Waters

The Department of Environmental Protection, Division of Environmental Assessment and Restoration, gives notice that a final order was entered on September 17, 2019 amending the Verified List of Impaired Waters for three waters in the Group 5 Indian River Lagoon basin due to the approval of the Mosquito Lagoon Reasonable Assurance Plan (RAP). The Mosquito Lagoon RAP is the product of a locally driven stakeholder initiative that establishes the restoration activities and projects that will address nutrient impairments in Mosquito Lagoon.

These amendments will be submitted to the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) pursuant to Section 303(d) of the federal Clean Water Act and shall serve to update the previously approved Section 303(d) list of Florida waters.
