Educational Flyer on Dumping and Waste Disposal

What is Illicit Discharge? Any discharge to a storm drain system that is not solely rainwater.

Pollutants that enter the storm drains and ditches in the City's drainage network are carried by rain water all the way to the lagoon and ocean.

We are counting on YOU to help protect the waters of Vero Beach.

Never pour anything down a storm drain. *Never* dump anything into a ditch or canal.



If I can't dump waste in the storm drain or ditch, where can I take my waste?

Indian River County has five Customer Convenience Centers where county residents can drop off garbage, recyclables, "sharps", scrap metal, tires, appliances, household hazardous waste (i.e. unused paints, chemicals, fertilizers), and yard waste at **NO CHARGE**.
