2017 Updates/STAR Report to Governor & State Legislature

- As of December 2017, 294 projects were completed in the BMAP area.
- In 2017, 52 projects added to the BMAP project list.
- Total estimated reductions:
 - 400,990 pounds per year (lb/yr) total nitrogen (TN) (70%) in the freshwater section.
 - 102,211 lb/yr total phosphorus (TP) (89%) in the freshwater section.
 - 2,816,993 lb/yr TN (119%) in the marine section.
