The final three measurements will be evaluated for each of the field parameters listed above (only the values in mg/L for DO) to ensure that representative measurements have been collected for a site. The lowest and highest values for the three measurements must be within 20% when calculating the relative percent difference (RPD). If these values are not within 20%, the final field measurement value will be qualified as being estimated with an F value qualifier.

$$RPD = \frac{(\text{Highest Value} - \text{Lowest Value})}{(\text{Mean Value of Highest and Lowest Values})} \times 100\%$$
