Sample Notes: The sample contained a large mat in pink water. The benthic attached diatoms, *Grammatophora* sp., *Coscinodiscus* sp., and *Fragilaria* sp., were abundant. Algae appeared alive and healthy.

Result: Dominant taxon was Lyngbya-like filamentous cyanobacteria (cf. *Lyngbya majuscula*)
