Sample Type¹ is used to indicate whether the sample was a grab (G) or whether it was a composite (C).

¹ "Simple Matrix" is used to indicate whether the sample is being discharged to drinking water (DW), groundwater (GW), surface water (SW), fresh surface water (FSW), saline surface water (SSW), salt sediment (SDMNT), or sludge (SLDG).

² "Container Type" is used to indicate whether the container is a grab (G) or flush (F).

Sample must be refrigerated or stored in wet ice after collection. The maximum temperature during storage should be 0°C (32°F). Under "Preservative" list any preservatives that were added to the sample container.

Each bottle has a hand identifying sample ID, premeasured preservative contained in the bottle, sample type, client ID, and purposes for analysis.

The following information should be added to each bottle label after collection with permanent black ink: date and time of collection, sampler's name or initials, and any field number or ID.

All bottles not containing preservative may be frozen with appropriate sample prior to collection.

The client is responsible for documentation of the sampling event. Please use specific sampling events on the sample control form.
