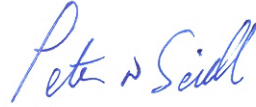
This letter is request a waiver for Specific Condition 17b of the referenced permit. The specific condition requires "annual surveys for a period of 3 years and biennially until the next beach nourishment event or the expiration of the design life" of the borrow area. Subsequent to the construction of this project, the borrow area permitted under this project was utilized for another Indian River County project for which a permit modification to that project was issued.

The Indian River Co. Sectors 1 & 2 Beach Restoration Project was completed in December 2007, and utilized the Sector 7 borrow area. The Department issued modification 0166929-010-EM for the Sectors 1 & 2 project allowing the Sector 7 borrow site to be used for that project. The Sectors 1 & 2 Post-Construction Physical Monitoring Report provides the survey data for the borrow site. Further, required under the Sectors 1 & 2 project permit, the borrow site will be surveyed and reported as part of the Sectors 1 & 2 post-project physical monitoring.

In summary, we are requesting that the Department waive the requirement of Specific Condition 17b of the 0215960-001-JC permit, as the post-project monitoring of the borrow site will occur under the Sectors 1 & 2 permit (0166929-007-EM) compliance. We look forward to the Department's response. Should you have any questions or concerns, I look forward to addressing them.
