RE: Glades County-DW Benbow Village WWTP FLA014263 Residuals Annual Summary

Dear Mr. Kleinmann:

After a review of the above referenced facility permit and as specified in Rule 62-640.650(5)(c), Florida Administrative Code the above mentioned Wastewater Treatment Plant **is not required to submit a Residuals Annual Summary**. The permit does not allow land application of biosolids and there was no land application of biosolids from this wastewater treatment plant.

Treatment Facility Biosolids Annual Summary. Permittees of wastewater treatment facilities or biosolids treatment facilities permitted for land application shall submit a summary of the shipment records required by paragraph 62-640.650(4)(d) and subsection 62-640.880(4), F.A.C., as applicable, to the appropriate District Office of the Department, or to the delegated local program, on an annual basis. The summary must be submitted on Department Form 62-640.210(2)(b), effective August 29, 2010, hereby adopted and incorporated by reference, and available from the Department of Environmental Protection, Domestic Wastewater Section, M.S. 3540, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400 or any of the Department's District Offices. The summary shall include all biosolids shipped during the period January 1 through December 31. The summary for each year shall be submitted to the Department by February 19 of the following year.

Since, the said wastewater treatment facility Permittee is not permitted to land apply the biosolids from this facility, the permittee did not submit a Residuals Annual Summary. This report is required to summarize a permittee's land application activities when a domestic wastewater facility permit authorizes the use of land application site(s). The facility's permit requires the biosolids to be transport to Tir na N' Og Ranch Biosolids Treatment Facility, 24 NE 325th Trail, Okeechobee, FL 34972-0253, for further treatment, that submits a Biosolids Annual Summary for their land application site(s) to FDEP.

As stated in Rule 62-640.880(1)(b) The source facility permittee shall not be held responsible for treatment, management, use, land application, or disposal violations that occur after its biosolids have been accepted by a permitted biosolids treatment facility with which the source facility permittee has an agreement in accordance with paragraph 62-640.880(1)(c), F.A.C., for further treatment, management, use, land application, or disposal.
