Dear Mr. Rutherford:

Beginning in December of 2009, both City of Fort Myers Wastewater Treatment Facilities began disposing of their biosolids via the Lee County Residuals Management Facility (RMF) – Permit Number FLA658189. At that time, all efforts to stabilize the biosolids became the responsibility of the RMF. As far as I can tell, there is no longer a requirement for the City of Fort Myers to file an annual residuals disposal report. All of the requirements for such a report are related to land application or incineration. The City did not land apply or incinerate any biosolids in 2010.
