This is the seventh meeting of the Stormwater Rulemaking Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) convened by the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP). This TAC was established to provide public input to DEP and Florida's water management districts (WMDs) related to anticipated rule development updating stormwater design and operation regulations under Part IV, Chapter 373, Florida Statutes. These rule updates will utilize the latest scientific information, as directed by Florida's Clean Waterways Act, specifically Section 5, Chapter 2020-150, Laws of Florida.
