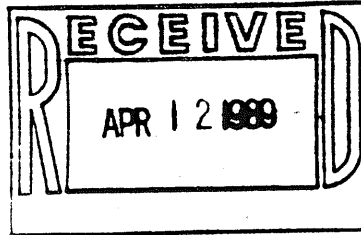

The National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) application recently submitted for the referenced facility has been reviewed and found to be incomplete for the following items:

1. Form 1, Items VIII.B. and C. - Data needs to be provided.
2. Form 2C, Item II.A. - Data documenting water balance should be included on the line drawing.
3. Form 2C, Item II.B. - Average flow data for outfalls 003 and 004 should be provided.
4. Form 2C, Item II.C. - Flow, volume, and duration data for the metal cleaning wastestream should be included.
5. Form 2C, Item IV - Data needs to be provided.
6. Form 2C, Item V.C., pages V6 - V9 - Pages should be completed.

Acknowledgement is made of receipt of your application on May 3, 1989 for a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit.

The renewal application will carry the same NPDES number FL0002283, as was previously assigned to this facility. Since you have submitted your renewal application prior to the expiration date, and it has been determined to be complete, your permit is automatically extended and you may continue to operate only in accordance with the terms of your existing permit, pursuant to 5 U.S.C. Section 558(c) of the Administrative Procedures Act, even if a renewal permit is not issued by the expiration date. The present permit will, therefore, remain fully effective and enforceable pending issuance of your new permit, and the monitoring and reporting requirements still apply. This extension is granted within the provisions of 40 CFR 122.6.
