The Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region IV, intends to issue a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit in accordance with the Federal Clean Water Act to the referenced facility in the near future.

The enclosed draft permit shows the proposed conditions to be incorporated as part of the final NPDES permit. Particular attention should be given to the effluent limitations, schedule of compliance, monitoring requirements, and reporting dates.

Comments relative to this draft permit are not required; however, if you wish to submit comments, please do so before April 6, 1992. Comments made during this time period may be incorporated into the draft permit prior to public notice. After this date, EPA will proceed with the permitting process, including requesting state certification and publicly noticing the draft permit. At the time of public notice, a copy of the notice will be sent to you. At that time, you will have an additional opportunity to comment on or object to any aspects of the draft permit.
