Dear Mr. Layman:

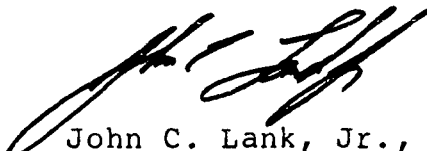
This is to notify you that your facility is in violation of the above-referenced NPDES permit as follows:

Both the minimum and maximum effluent limitations for pH were exceeded for the month of January 1982 as noted on your Discharge Monitoring Reports.

Until such time as you achieve compliance with all conditions of your NPDES permit, you are considered to be in violation of and subject to enforcement actions pursuant to Section 309 of the Clean Water Act.
