- Sanitary wastewater
- Effluent from septic tanks
- Car wash wastewaters
- Improper oil disposal
- Radiator flushing disposal
- Laundry wastewaters
- Spills from roadway accidents.
- Improper disposal of auto and household toxics.
- Grass clippings, soil, and yard debris.
- Common litter like plastic bottles, cans, wrappers, and cigarette butts.

Car wash wastewaters and power washing of parking lots/buildings are common forms of Illicit Discharge.

- Stabilize exposed areas as soon as land alterations are complete.

- Protect storm drains.

- Keep excess silts and soils from roadways.

- Cover or seed dirt stockpiles.

- Blow leaves, grass clippings, soil, and yard debris onto property, not the roadway.

- Make sure there are receptacles at your business, so your employees/customers are not littering or tossing cigarette butts into the street.

- Protect natural features (i.e. trees, shrubs, bodies of water, vegetative buffers).

How To Help

- Recycle as many cans, bottles, plastic/glass containers, and construction debris as possible.
- Keep excess silts and soils from roadways.
- Use environmentally friendly cleaning products and chemicals and prevent them from reaching the roadways.
