



Additional Information and Drawing Checklist

Artificial Lake or Pond

Artificial Lake or Pond is a completely artificial body of water excavated entirely in uplands, that is not created by impoundment or other alteration of wetlands or other surface waters.

Use this checklist to check your application for completeness. Make sure all applicable information is included. This checklist is intended to supplement, not replace, the general information requirements outlined in Sections D and E of the Joint Application.

Written Description (use additional sheets if needed)

- ☐ The use and purpose of the water body
- ☐ How the water levels will be regulated
- ☐ Temporary and permanent slope stabilization
- ☐ Erosion and sedimentation controls
- ☐ The landscaping or planting plan, if any, including:
 - Plant species
 - Spacing
 - Quantity
 - Location
 - Source of plants
 - Sizes of plants
- ☐ Whether the lake or pond will be connected in any way to wetlands or other surface waters (by a pipe, ditch, etc.)

Drawing Items (to be included in addition to general drawing requirements listed in the General Checklist)

- ☐ Length, width, maximum depth, side slope ratio (Horizontal: Vertical), and total surface area of the waterbody
- ☐ Detailed drawings of the structure that will regulate water levels
- ☐ Control water, high water and normal pool elevations, referenced to NGVD or NAVD
- ☐ Erosion, sedimentation and turbidity controls
- ☐ Temporary and permanent slope stabilization methods
- ☐ Planting plan
