



Additional Information and Drawing Checklist

Roads, Bridges, Causeways, Culverts

Roads, Bridges, Causeways and Culverts are transportation projects. This checklist may be used for all types of transportation projects.

Check to see if your project qualifies for an exemption or a Noticed General Permit (NGP) before filling out the individual permit application. Exemptions and NGPs exist for certain small bridge replacements, culverted driveways, roadway crossings, bridges and certain FDOT activities.

If your project is in, on or over State-owned submerged lands, a proprietary easement may be required.

Use this checklist to check your application for completeness. Make sure all applicable information is included. This checklist is intended to supplement, not replace, the general information requirements outlined in Sections D and E of the Joint Application.

Written Description (use additional sheets)

- ☐ Describe if the proposed project is maintenance, improvement of an existing structure or new work
- ☐ Describe the existing and proposed activities to be located at the project site, include a description of channels, borrow sites, bridges, groins, jetties, pipelines or other utility crossings, and any other structure or activities
- ☐ If demucking is proposed, provide the estimated cubic yardage and location of the storage or disposal site of the muck, and whether or not the muck will be used as slope dressing
- ☐ If waterway diversion will be required, describe how this will be accomplished
- ☐ If a bridge will be replaced, describe how this will be accomplished, including whether a work bridge, work channel, detour bridge, or other structure or disturbance will occur at the project site
- ☐ Describe proposed contractor equipment staging area. If the staging area is not known, describe how the staging area will be kept out of wetlands or other surface waters
- ☐ Provide a detailed description of construction methods and equipment. Include timing and staging of the project. Include a description of materials to be used

- ☐ Describe any dewatering methods proposed
- ☐ If the project is in, on or over marine or fresh waters (as applicable):
 - Hydrographic testing may be required, contact the Department to schedule a pre-application meeting

Drawing Items (to be included in addition to general drawing requirements listed in the General Checklist)

- ☐ All drawings must be signed and sealed by an appropriate Florida registered professional
- ☐ Show all horizontal and vertical dimensions of the proposed work including any structures
- ☐ Show boundaries of wetlands and other surface waters
- ☐ If demucking is proposed, show the location of the storage or disposal site of the muck
- ☐ Show details of any proposed waterway diversion, including a plan and cross-section view
- ☐ Provide fully dimensioned or scaled cross sectional views of typical roadway sections and work proposed at culvert or bridge locations.
- ☐ Show location of proposed contractor staging area
- ☐ Show location, size, number composition and invert elevation of any proposed culverts
- ☐ If dewatering is proposed, provide a dewatering plan drawing
- ☐ Show location and type of erosion, sedimentation and turbidity controls
- ☐ Show all details of the structure in plan view and cross-section drawings
