Go to www.google.com and key in "coreftp" in the search field. Go to the coreftp website, then download the latest free ftp client software to your desktop and install it.

Then, launch Core FTP Lite (it should install a desktop icon). A pop-up will come up and ask if you want Core FTP Lite to be your default ftp client. Click on "No", then it will ask if you want to use notepad.exe for your ascii editor. Click on "Yes". Once the program opens, key in the following information:

Site Name: CCPA Public FTP

Host/ IP / URL: <ftp.ccpao.com>

User Name: public@ccpao.com

Password: clay

Then click on connect.

You should now be on the remote ftp site for CCPAO.com. This is a public access folder, so people can both upload and download data.

Or,

Launch Filezilla Client. It will check to see if there is a newer version available. If there is, download and install it as instructed. In this instance, there shouldn't be. You will have to go to "Start", "Programs", "Filezilla FTP Client" and drag a copy of the "Filezilla" icon to your desktop. Once it is

opened, key in the following info:

Host/ IP / URL: <ftp.ccpao.com>

User Name: public@ccpao.com

Password: clay

Port: 21

Then click on "Quickconnect".

You should now be on the remote ftp site for CCPAO.com. This is just a different way to get to the public access folder, so people can both upload and download data.

Try it and let me know how it works for you.
