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**BREVARD COUNTY AGENCY REPORT
FOR THE
FLORIDA ENERGYSECURE LINE PROJECT**

In accordance with Section 62-807.480, Florida Statutes, Brevard County hereby presents its Agency Report related to the Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) EnergySecure Line Project gas transmission line corridor to be located in Brevard County. The County represents that there are no County non-procedural requirements not specifically listed in the Florida EnergySecure Line Project gas transmission line corridor plans from which a variance, waiver, exemption or other relief is necessary in order for the Florida EnergySecure Line Project to be certified.

The County recommends approval of the certification for the Florida EnergySecure Line Project, subject to the following conditions, which conditions shall be binding on the Florida Power & Light Company, or their assigns:

Meetings/Document/Submittal Requirements

The Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) must schedule a meeting with Brevard County right-of-way permitting staff within 30-days of the actual gas transmission line route being established within the Florida EnergySecure Line Project gas transmission line corridor. At that time, Brevard County Staff will review the gas transmission line route with FPL and discuss the construction requirements for the gas transmission line crossings of Brevard County roadways and any gas transmission lines placed in County controlled easements. Once this meeting is complete and the necessary changes are made to the construction documents, FPL must submit finalized construction drawings to the Brevard County Planning and Development Land Development section. The finalized construction drawings will be reviewed for compliance with Brevard County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 86, Roads and Bridges, Division 2, Standards, Section 86-69, Design and Construction Requirements.

Application Review Fee

Concurrent with the submittal of the finalized construction drawings required in paragraph above, the applicant shall pay all of the county's fees for staff review of the required construction drawings, permits, and inspections associated with the gas transmission line crossings of Brevard County roadways and any gas transmission lines placed in County controlled easements. Fees for the above process have been established per Brevard County Code of Ordinances, Chapter 86, Roads and Bridges, Article III, Division 3, Section 86-104 and Brevard County Resolution 2008-025.
