Dear Ms. Seiler:

As per Chapter 62-807.480 of the Natural Gas Transmission Pipeline Siting Act, the Suwannee River Water Management District herewith files its agency report in subject case:

- (a) The Suwannee River Water Management District does not have any nonprocedural requirement not already listed in the case application from which a variance, exemption, exception, or other relief is necessary in order for the proposed corridor to be certified.
- (b) The Suwannee River Water Management District recommends approval of the application proposed by Florida Power & Light Company.
- (c) The Suwannee River Water Management District has the following condition of certification for the proposed corridor of the Florida EnergySecure Line:

Prior to commencing construction of the Bradford County compressor station, FPL will provide a detailed water budget for the site to the Suwannee River Water Management District. Once the station becomes operational, monthly water use at the site will be recorded, if required by the applicable rule, and submitted to the District on a yearly basis.
