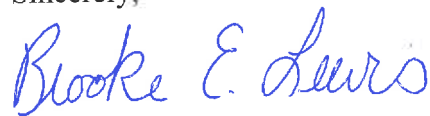

NOTICE OF CANCELLATION OF CERTIFICATION HEARING FLORIDA POWER & LIGHT COMPANY OKEECHOBEE CLEAN ENERGY CENTER

1. The certification hearing for the Okeechobee Clean Energy Center, Power Plant Siting Application No. PA15-58, DOAH Case No. 15-5540-EPP, OGC Case No. 15-0607, which was scheduled to be held beginning June 20, 2016, at The Holiday Inn Express and Suites, 3101 U.S. Highway 441 South, in Okeechobee, Florida, has been cancelled. In accordance with the Florida Electrical Power Plant Siting Act, Section 403.508(6), Florida Statutes (F.S.), on May 24, 2016, all parties to this proceeding stipulated that there are no disputed issues of material fact or law to be raised at the certification hearing. Accordingly, on May 24, 2016, the Administrative Law Judge issued an order granting a request to cancel the hearing and relinquish jurisdiction to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) for entry of a final order of certification, subject to proposed conditions.

2. Pursuant to Section 403.509(1)(a), F.S., FDEP will issue a final order on certification within 40 days of the Administrative Law Judge's order canceling the certification hearing.

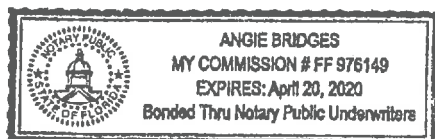

3. A landscaper told law enforcement he had found the phone in a ditch in Orange County, and that a person named Jorge had called the phone and told the man he could keep it.

The Samsung phone was turned over to law enforcement and on June 5 a forensic examination was done on the phone. That exam turned up a number of 'selfies' of Guerrero as well as "... multiple images of child pornography," stated the complaint.

Sgt. Payne indicated in his complaint that the child and/or children on the phone have not yet been identified.

A local search at the Okeechobee County Sheriff's Office (OCSO) also found records where Guerrero was arrested April 10, 2013, in Okeechobee County.

Michele Bell, OCSO public information officer, said Guerrero was arrested on charges of leaving the scene of an accident with property damage, no valid driver's license and resisting a law enforcement officer without violence.

It is not yet clear when Guerrero left Okeechobee and moved in with the little girl and her family in Fort Myers.

three hurricanes seasons during their peak months," he stated.

The 2016 forecast calls for 10-16 named storms, with 4 to 8 becoming hurricanes. One to four of those storms are expected to be major hurricanes.

In other business Thursday, the board will be asked to schedule a workshop to review the standards and processes associated with the Insurance Services Office. According to the county staff report, the Insurance Services Office (ISO) evaluates several areas of fire protection related items that ultimately leading to the Public Protection Classification rating for the county. This rating then translates into Home Owner's Insurance rate determinations formulas.

Fire Rescue has arranged for a ISO representative from Verisk Insurance Solution to provide a workshop to the board regarding the ISO process.

The commissioners will also consider approval of a grant agreement and certifications between the Florida Department of State, Division of Elections and Okeechobee County for receipt and use of Voting System Assistance Grant FUNDING in the amount of \$69,696 paid over 5 years in the amount of \$13,939 annually.

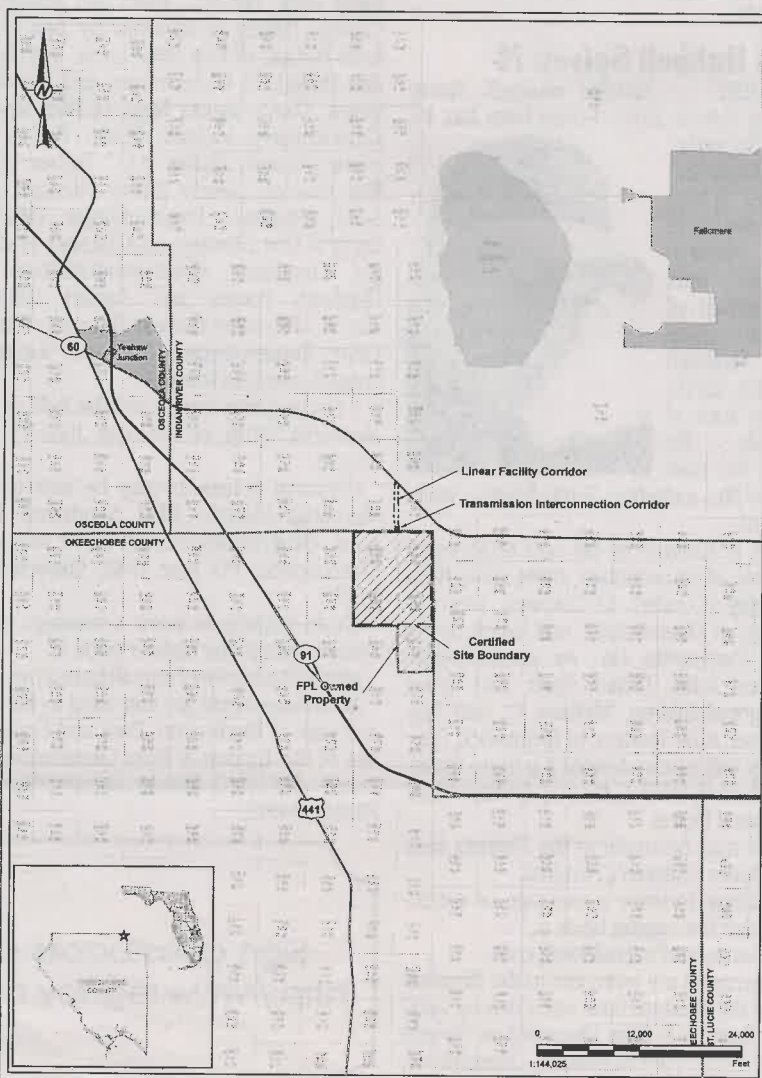

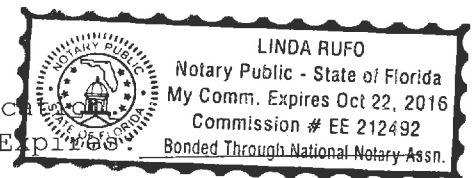
