In accordance with the procedures contained in Chapters 403 and 267, Florida Statutes, this agency reviewed the referenced certification application. We previously reviewed the proposed certification in April and June of 2012. We have no concerns regarding potential impacts to historical resources related to the Port Everglades application. No recorded historic properties are located within the plant property boundaries. This agency approves the certification of this power plant.

This agency notes that in April we commented that we were waiting for a Florida Master Site File form and evaluation of the 1961 power plant (now more than 50 years of age). We have not received this site form to date.
