Dear Ms. Mulkey:

Florida Power & Light Company (FPL) requests a post-certification amendment to the Site Certification Application for FPL's Turkey Point Clean Energy Center, pursuant to S. 403.5113, Florida Statutes, and Rule 62-17.205(1), Florida Administrative Code. The purpose of this amendment request is to obtain approval for installing asphalt pavement in two areas.

All proposed paving will be located within the certified boundary in areas already assumed to be impervious in the original certification and will not alter the stormwater calculations. The two pavement areas include:

1. A 210-foot x 35-foot area east of the cooling towers and units.
2. A 125-foot x 10-foot area located west of Unit 5D.

The proposed pavement area east of the cooling towers and units currently houses several dumpsters. The proposed pavement will provide both safer and easier access to this area for forklifts, truck drivers, and other such traffic. The proposed pavement area west of Unit 5D will provide more direct access between existing paved areas. The pavement area locations are provided in Attachment A.

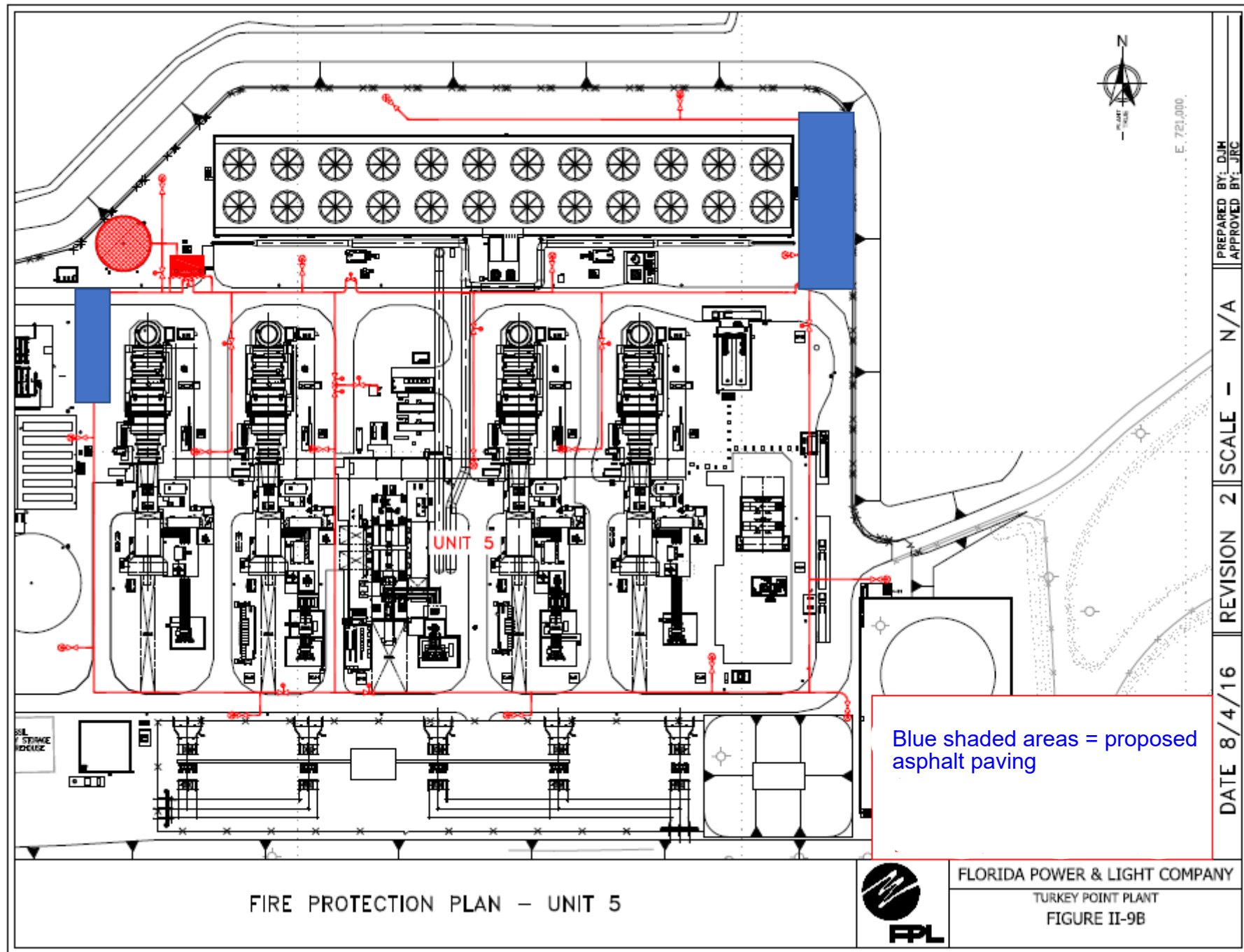
