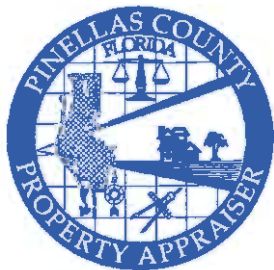
Dear Mr. Smith:

I have reviewed the material attached to your letter of July 6, 1998, concerning equipment used for the purpose of pollution control at the Resource Recycling, LLC, facility located in Pinellas County, Florida. Without further explanation, I can not agree or determine that the all of the equipment listed on Line 20 - Special Industry Assets - is primarily for the purpose of pollution control. I can not find all of the equipment eligible. I can determine that the Air System with Scrubber originally costing \$195,000, is eligible for assessment at salvage value pursuant to section 193.621, Florida Statutes. There may be other items of eligible equipment. In my opinion, the primary purpose of most of the listed equipment is for the separation of ash from recoverable metals. The metals would be sold for profit. The ash is presumable sent to the Pinellas County or other licensed landfill. Any air handling system used to collect and filter out dust produced by the handling of the ash is eligible as pollution control equipment.

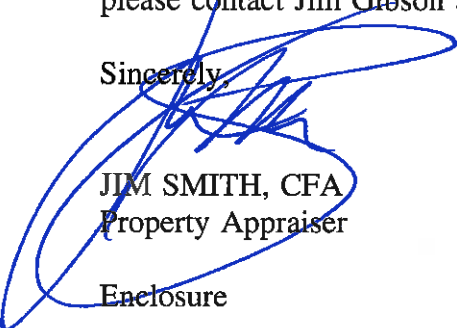

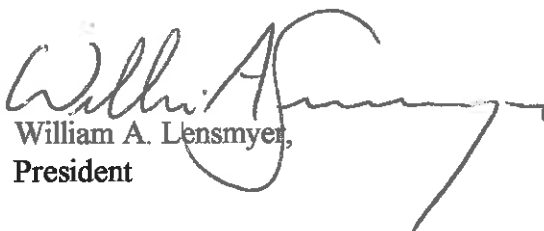

This processing of the ash is necessary to support the county's waste to energy process for land fill volume reduction. This overall process supports the reduction of decaying organic material that causes the unwanted creation and release of methane gas (ie. air pollution). The equipment is subject to the assessment criteria qualifying under Florida Statue Section 193.621.
