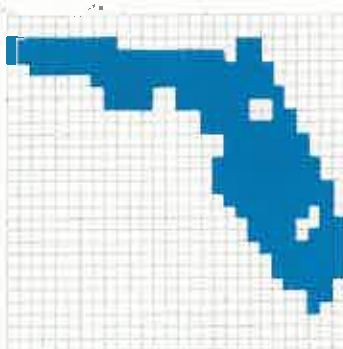

Dear Ms. Denton:

The following letter is provided in response to your request to Mr. Brian Perry for a description of pollution control equipment and its function listed at the Georgia-Pacific Hawthorne Plywood facility.

1. **Sander Dust System:** This is a baghouse that collects sanderdust from the pneumatic system which is part of the sander system. The baghouse serves as an environmental control for air pollution control.
2. **Dryer Washdown System:** This equipment collects and screens water used to wash the dryer and then re-uses the water by re-injecting the water into the dryer for moisture. This provides two benefits for the environment. It provides pollution control by preventing discharge of the dirty water and reduces water consumption for moisture injection.
3. **Manual Deluge System:** this is a fire control system.
4. **Dryer Condensate, Vat Condensate, and Press Condensate** projects are all similar pollution control projects. The condensate collection systems collect condensate that is contaminated with boiler chemicals and recycles the water back to the boiler. This prevents the potential discharge of the contaminated water.

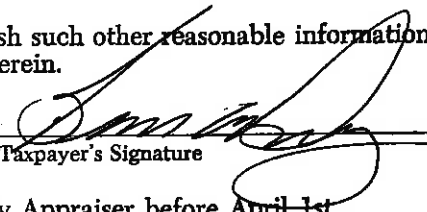
