Hello Everyone.

Preliminary Statements of Issues (PSIs) for the SHEC Shady Hills Combined Cycle Facility site certification application are due **Wednesday, June 27, 2018**.

In plain language, we are looking for any issues that your agency foresees as being potentially problematic, or that may create difficulties with certification or with drafting conditions of certification, particularly those that may be cause for your agency to consider a recommendation of denial to the Department.

It is not uncommon for an agency to have no preliminary issues. If that is the case, you may

submit a statement that your agency has no issues at this time. These statements are designed to give the Department and the applicant a “heads-up” on where your agency stands, and an indication of what other issues are likely to come up during the remainder of the certification process.

Note also that, if an issue is not included in this preliminary statement, it doesn’t mean that the issue cannot be raised in your “agency report” (due August 24, 2018 for FWC, DOT, DOS/DHR, SWFWMD and DEP SWD; due August 31, 2018 for DEO/Pasco County). However, to the extent possible, any issues that you are aware of should be included in your preliminary statement.

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403.507 Preliminary statements of issues, reports, project analyses, and studies.—

(1) Each affected agency identified in paragraph (2)(a) shall submit a preliminary statement of issues to the department, the applicant, and all parties no later than 40 days after the certification application has been determined complete. The failure to raise an issue in this statement shall not preclude the issue from being raised in the agency’s report.
