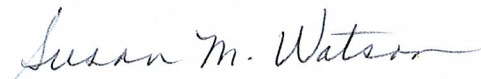
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SITING COORDINATION

Dear Ms. Seiler,

I want to thank you for answering my questions (per phone conversation 12/15/10) regarding the proposed corridor of the Willow Oak – Wheeler – Davis 230K Transmission Line (phase 2). As a party to the hearing I am requesting all of the information regarding permitting and the conditions for certification as well as the agencies which will be involved with the permitting. I am enclosing a copy of the Seffner – Mango Community Plan. The Seffner (which includes part of Dover)–Mango area has over 20,000 residents. This plan represents the residents' vision of what they want their community to be. This plan is the product of three years study and research as well as hundreds of hours of working committee (representatives from neighborhoods) meetings, two well attended Community Open Houses and full room multiple presentations in front of the Hillsborough County Planning Committee and the Hillsborough County Commission. This plan was voted on and approved by both the Planning Commission, the County Commission, and sent to Tallahassee. If you review the plan, you can see that the number one priority is to "ensure protection of the environment, including the wetlands and wildlife habitat protection." If you refer to the map, it is the same area surrounding the eagles' nest and the area that is in question regarding the proposed corridor. Please advise me as to where this information needs to be sent. I appreciate your assistance regarding this very important matter to the residents of our community. Thank you.
