NOTICE OF MODIFICATION OF CERTIFIED TRANSMISSION LINE CORRIDOR REQUEST FORM

Persons who were not parties to the certification proceeding and whose substantial interests are affected by the proposed modification and who object to it must file their objections in writing with the Department of Environmental Protection, Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, MS35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, during normal business hours, within 30 days of the publication of this Notice, or within 30 days of publication of the Department's Notice of Intent in the Florida Administrative Weekly, whichever occurs later. A copy of such objection must be served on all parties to

the certification proceeding. (A list of parties may be obtained from the Department's Siting Coordination Office at the physical address above.) Persons who fail to have the objection filed with (received by) the Department within the prescribed time period will have waived their right to object.
