Dear Mr. Casey:

The Department of Environmental Protection's Siting Office (Department) is in receipt of your July 14, 2008 request (included as attachment) to modify the approved schedule for ash conveyor replacement at the Miami-Dade Resources Recovery Facility.

On June 5, 2008 the Department received a request for a post certification amendment to the application for the Miami-Dade Resources Recovery Facility to replace the ash conveyors at the facility. The Department determined on July 7, 2008 that the request was an amendment to the application that did not require modification to the Conditions of Certification pursuant to Section 62-17.205(c), F.A.C. Approval for the ash conveyor replacement was granted for mid-August, over a period of approximately two weeks. That approval (also included as attachment) expires on September 30, 2008.

The Department acknowledges your July 14, 2008 request to alter the ash conveyor replacement schedule. By this letter, ash conveyor replacement is now approved for the period of November 5th through no later than November 28th, as identified in your July 14, 2008 request. This schedule replaces the previous schedule as set forth in the Department's July 7, 2008 approval and will expire on December 15, 2008. No other changes are authorized, and all previous and existing requirements remain intact. This letter should be attached to the July 7th approval and made available on-site for review by those agencies with regulatory authority.

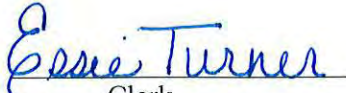
