FINAL ORDER MODIFYING
CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION

On July 2, 1991, Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc. (SECI) submitted a Proposed Agreement to modify a specific portion of the Florida Electrical Power Plant Siting Act Certification Order governing the Hardee Power Station and associated facilities. More specifically, SECI requested authorization to utilize steel instead of wood for transmission line structures in the Cecil M. Webb Wildlife Management Area in Charlotte County, as explained in an attachment to the Proposed Agreement. SECI served a copy of its Proposed Agreement to all parties to the certification proceeding by certified mail on July 2, 1991.

On August 2, 1991, the Department of Environmental Regulation published in Florida Administrative Weekly notice of SECI's Proposed Modification to the Hardee Power Station Certification Order. No party or other person has objected to the Proposed Modification. Accordingly, pursuant to Section 403.516(1)(b), Fla. Stat., IT IS ORDERED:

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Condition XXXVI E.12. is added to the Conditions of Certification and shall provide as follows:

H-frame transmission line structures emplaced within the Webb Wildlife Management Area may be constructed of steel.

NOTICE OF RIGHTS

Any party to this Order has the right to seek judicial review of this Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes by filing a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department in the Office of the General Counsel, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400; and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal accompanied by the appropriate filing fees with the appropriate district court of appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date of the Final Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department.
