FINAL ORDER APPROVING CERTIFICATION

On April 29, 1991, Hearing Officer Don W. Davis of the Division of Administrative Hearings (DOAH) issued the attached Recommended Order in the above-styled case recommending certification of a transmission line corridor proposed by Applicants Seminole Electric Cooperative, Inc. and Jacksonville Electric Authority. No exceptions to the Recommended Order were filed.

The Siting Board has reviewed the Recommended Order and, in accordance with Section 120.57(1)(b)(10), Florida Statutes,
ORDERS

1. The Recommended Order is adopted by the Siting Board as its final order.

2. The Seminole Plant-Keystone-JEA Firestone 230 kV transmission line corridor is CERTIFIED subject to the Conditions of Certification contained in Appendix C of the Recommended Order.

3. Pursuant to Section 403.531(2), Florida Statutes (Supp. 1990), the Applicants are granted special zoning exceptions to

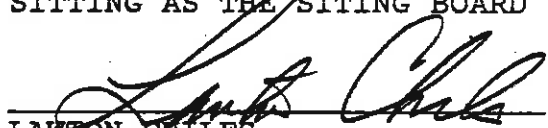
allow construction of the transmission line in Putnam County; and to allow location of the line with the General Floodplain District of the City of Jacksonville/Duval County.

4. The Department of Environmental Regulation is delegated the responsibility to enforce compliance with the Conditions of Certification in accordance with Sections 403.141 and 403.161, Florida Statutes.

Any party to this Order has the right to seek judicial review of the Order pursuant to Section 120.68, Florida Statutes, by the filing of a Notice of Appeal pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the clerk of the Department of Environmental Regulation in the Office of General Counsel, 2600 Blair Stone Road, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-2400; and by filing a copy of the Notice of appeal accompanied by the applicable filing fees with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Order is filed with the clerk of the Department of Environmental Regulation.

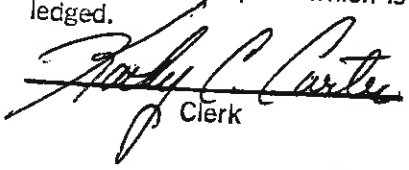
