FINAL ORDER MODIFYING CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION

Dear Ms. Krupa:

Pursuant to Section 403.511(5)(a), Florida Statutes (F.S.), a certified electrical power plant shall comply with rules adopted by the Department of Environmental Protection (Department) subsequent to the issuance of the certification which prescribe new or stricter criteria. Subsequently adopted rules which prescribe new or stricter criteria shall operate as automatic modifications to certifications. The Florida Siting Board issued a Site Certification to the Solid Waste Authority for the construction and operation of the Palm Beach County Renewable Energy Park Facility 1 and Facility 2 expansion on July 29, 1986, and September 1, 2011, respectively, in Palm Beach County.

The Department revised Chapter 62-640, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), to require additional nutrient monitoring in all biosolids. These rule revisions became effective on June 21, 2021. In accordance with Section 403.516(1)(d), F.S., the Department hereby modifies the Conditions of Certification (Conditions) for the Palm Beach Renewable Energy Park to include applicable monitoring for Water Extractable Phosphorus at the Biosolids Pelletization Facility.

Any party to the this Order has a right to seek judicial review of it pursuant to Section 120.68, F.S. by filing a Notice of Appeal, pursuant to Rule 9.110, Florida Rules of Appellate Procedure, with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection in the Office of General Counsel, 3900 Commonwealth Boulevard, M.S. 35, Tallahassee, Florida 32399-3000, and by filing a copy of the Notice of Appeal, accompanied by the applicable filing fees, with the appropriate District Court of Appeal. The Notice of Appeal must be filed within 30 days from the date this Order is filed with the Clerk of the Department of Environmental Protection.
