MODIFICATION ORDER

BY THE GOVERNOR AND CABINET:

The Governor and Cabinet, having carefully reviewed the
Petition for Modification of Terms of Certification, the certifi-
cation previously granted herein, and the Hearing Officer's Findings
of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommended Order and being other-
wise fully advised herein, it is

ORDERED:

1. The Hearing Officer's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of
Law, and Recommended Order are approved and adopted in toto. A
typographical error on page 7, line 2 is corrected to change the
number of riser pipes from 50 to 58.

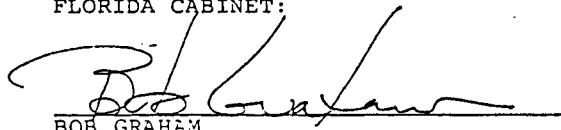


2. The Petition to Modify the Terms of Certification is granted subject to all conditions of certification previously imposed and also to the following:

- a. Condition V. 3. that the dike around the mangrove area North of the discharge canal be opened up to Big Mud Creek by breaching in three places. Each breach in the dike shall be a minimum of ten feet wide at the bottom and the bottom elevation of the breach shall not be higher than one foot below mean sea level or deeper than -3 feet mean sea level.
- b. Condition X. b. that the Department of Natural Resources, Bureau of Beaches and Shores be allowed to inspect the dune once restored.

DONE AND ORDERED this 7th day of April, 1980, subsequent to a vote of the Governor and Cabinet at a duly constituted Cabinet meeting of April 1, 1980.
