FINAL ORDER
MODIFYING CONDITIONS OF CERTIFICATION
(CORRECTED)

The Florida Department of Environmental Regulation after notice and opportunity for hearing modifies the conditions of certification for the St. Lucie Power Plant Unit No. 2 pursuant to Section 403.516(1), Florida Statutes, and Section 10 of the General Conditions of Certification, which delegated modifications of conditions to the Department.

1. On November 30, 1981, Florida Power and Light Company submitted an application to the Department requesting modification of the existing Conditions of Certification for St. Lucie Power Plant Unit No. 2 to allow construction of a third intake pipe. A copy of that application is attached as Exhibit A.

2. On January 15, 1982, a Notice of Proposed Agency Action was served on all parties with a provision that a hearing would be held if requested on or before January 29, 1982. No hearing was requested; therefore, the Department adopts the proposed agency action as final.

3. After review of the application and its exhibits, the Department grants relief to Florida Power and Light by approving the application subject to Special Conditions V, X, and XI, and by making the following modifications to the

Conditions of Certification:

a. Condition X.B.

B. Dunes - In restoring the ocean dune to its original condition after installation of the Unit No. 2 discharge and intake lines, the permittee will replant the dune at the earliest feasible time with dune stabilizing plants native to the area, such as sea oats (Uniola paniculata) or sea grape (Coccoloba uvifera). The Department of Natural Resources, Bureau of Beaches and Shores shall be allowed to inspect the dune once restored.

b. Condition XI.A.

A. Discharge and Intake Lines
