Project Description
The Manatee County Shore Protection Project, or Central Beach Project, consists of the nourishment of 4.7 miles of shoreline between DEP monuments R12 and R36 in Manatee County. The project was restored in 1993 and nourished in 2003, 2006, 2014, and 2020. In 2016, a storm repair project was completed between R34 and R41 with FEMA funds for Hurricane Hermine and Hurricane Irma. The next nourishment is scheduled for 2030/2031. The requested funds are for the year 2 post-construction environmental (sea turtle and shorebird) and hardbottom monitoring from the 2020 nourishment event. Staff have determined that 100% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
