Project Description
The Jupiter Island Beach Nourishment and Blowing Rocks Dune Project consists of approximately 7 miles of shoreline from R73 to R111 and R125+250' to R127+400' in Martin County. The project has had regular nourishments since 1973, with the most recent nourishment completed in 2020/2021 to repair damages from Hurricane Dorian. The Blowing Rocks dune component was nourished in 2012, 2014, 2017, and 2020. The requested funds are for year 2 post-construction monitoring. Staff have determined that 38% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
