The South Amelia Island Beach Nourishment Project consists of 3.6 miles of shoreline and is located between DEP monuments R59 and R79 in Nassau County. The restoration was completed in 1994 and nourishments were completed in 2002 and 2011. A third and the most recent nourishment was completed in summer of 2021. The requested funds are for year 2 post-construction monitoring for the 2021 event. Staff have determined that 85.44% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
