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2 A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF BOCA RATON
3 SUPPORTING THE BEACH AND COASTAL
4 MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS OF THE FLORIDA
5 DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION,
6 SUBJECT TO THE CITY'S REGULATORY AUTHORITY
7 AND CODE OF ORDINANCES; ADVISING THE STATE
8 THAT THE CITY WILL HAVE THE ABILITY TO PROVIDE
9 THE LOCAL FUNDING SHARE NECESSARY TO
10 IMPLEMENT THE STATE BEACH AND COASTAL
11 MANAGEMENT PROGRAMS IN WHICH THE CITY
12 ELECTS TO PARTICIPATE; AUTHORIZING THE CITY
13 MANAGER TO FORWARD A LONG-RANGE BEACH
14 FUNDING PLAN TO THE STATE; PROVIDING FOR
15 SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR REPEALER;
16 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE
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1 WHEREAS, the City of Boca Raton ("City") desires to support the beach and coastal
2 management programs of the Florida Department of Environmental Protection ("FDEP"), subject
3 to the City's regulatory authority and the Code of Ordinances; and

4 WHEREAS, the City desires to advise the State that the City will have the ability to
5 provide the local funding share necessary to implement the state beach and coastal
6 management programs in which the City elects to participate; and

7 WHEREAS, the City adopts, on a yearly basis, the Capital Improvement Program
8 which appropriates the funds necessary for the continued maintenance and construction of the
9 beach nourishment projects; and

10 WHEREAS, the City wishes to forward the City's intent of long-term maintenance and
11 funding of its beach and Coastal Management Programs to the State; now therefore

13 BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BOCA
14 RATON:

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16 Section 1. That the City hereby supports the beach and coastal management
17 programs of the FDEP, subject to the City's regulatory authority and the Code of Ordinances.

18 Section 2. That the City will have the ability to provide the local share necessary to
19 implement any of the FDEP beach and coastal management programs in which the City elects
20 to participate.

21 Section 3. That the City Manager is hereby authorized and directed to forward the
22 long-range funding plans to the FDEP, copies of which are attached as Composite Exhibit "A";
23 provided, however, the funding of any local share of any FDEP project may be subject to: (a)
24 further action of the City Council; and (b) annual funding.

25 Section 4. If any section, subsection, clause or provision of this resolution is held
26 invalid, the remainder shall not be affected by such invalidity.

Section 5. All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith shall be and hereby are repealed.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately after adoption.
