Project Description
The Ft. Pierce Shore Protection Project is located between DEP monuments R34 and R46 in St. Lucie County. Initial restoration of the project occurred in 1971 and later nourishment in 1981. The Project was reauthorized by Congress in 1986, through 2020, and in the Water Resources Development Act 2018 the project lifespan was extended to 2026. Fifteen nourishments have been completed since 1999, and the next nourishment is scheduled for 2022/2023. The requested funds are for post-construction physical and biological monitoring and tilling. Staff have determined that 100% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
