The Navarre Beach Nourishment Project is located between DEP monuments R192+460' and R213+650' in Santa Rosa County. The Project was initially restored in 2006, placing approximately 2,952,889 cubic yards of sand to construct the beach and dune. The project was nourished again in 2016. Hurricane Sally caused storm damages and losses in September of 2020. The requested funds are for year two post construction monitoring. Staff have determined that 100% of the non- federal project is eligible for state cost sharing.
