Project Description
The Project extends between R-12 & R-36 and was nourished originally in 1992. In August 2016, Hurricane Hermine and Irma cause major sand loss along Coquina Beach extending outside the project area. However, FEMA provided federal funds for the storm repair between R-34 & R-41. In 2020, across Anna Maria Island, there was a beach nourishment event that included a federal portion. Following USACE construction, Manatee County completed FEMA funded storm restoration in March 2021. This project consists of Monitoring and requests confirmation that 2-year & 3-year Hardbottom Monitoring for the federal portion of the beach nourishment project is included in existing agreements. LS staff have determined that 50% of the project is eligible for state cost share.
