Project Description The South Lake Worth Inlet (also known as Boynton Inlet) is located between DEP monuments R151 and R152 in Palm Beach County. The Inlet Management Plan (IMP) was adopted in March 1999, establishing an annual bypassing objective of 88,000 cubic yards of sand with 60,000 cubic yards to be bypassed by the sand transfer plant. The interior deposition basin (sand trap) was expanded in 2002 and in 2009 it was reconstructed. Seagrass mitigation was completed in 2014 and maintenance dredging was completed in 2015. A new sediment budget study has been finalized and will be a component of an updated IMP. The requested funds are for design and monitoring. Staff have determined that the remaining design tasks and monitoring tasks are eligible for a 50% state cost share.
