Project Description
The St. Johns County Shore Protection Program project consists of approximately 2.7 miles of shoreline in St. Johns County, between DEP reference monuments R-137 and R- 151. Restoration of the federal project and the non-federal extension within the state recreation area was completed in 2003. An emergency nourishment was completed in 2005 to address damages sustained during the 2004 hurricane season. Nourishment was completed in 2012, 2018, and scheduled for 2023. The requested funds are for post- construction monitoring. Staff have determined that 87.12% of the non federal share is eligible for state cost sharing.
