Project Description
The federally-authorized Bakers Haulover Inlet is located between DEP monuments R7 and R38 in Miami-Dade County. The FDEP Inlet Management Plan (IMP) was adopted in 1997 and last updated in 2021. A comprehensive beach and inlet hydrographic monitoring program shall be conducted to evaluate the performance and impact of existing sand bypassing and nourishment projects, and to periodically update the inlet sediment budget. The requested funds are for topographic and hydrographic surveys of the inlet system, its ebb and flood shoals, and adjoining beaches. Staff have determined that the project is eligible for a 50% state cost share.
