Project Description
The federally-authorized North Boca Raton Shore Protection Project is located between DEP monuments R205 and R212+181 in Palm Beach County. The ~1.45 mile long project had its fourth renourishment completed in March and April 2020 by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) using Flood Control and Costal Emrgencies (FCCE) funds in response to impacts from Hurricane Matthew. The fifth renourishment is currently scheduled for FY28/29 in conjunction with the Central Boca Raton renourishment. Physical monitoring of the North Boca Raton Beach occurs annually in conjunction with the City Wide beach and shoreline monitoring (beginning in 2024). The requested funds are for sixth year post-construction monitoring following the 2020 FCCE event. Staff have determined that 100% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
