Project Description
The Panama City Beaches Shore Protection Project consists of 18 miles of shoreline from DEP monuments R-1 to R-91 in Bay County. The project was restored in 1998/99 and was nourished in 2006 and 2017. The project sustained erosion from Hurricane Michael in 2019 and Hurricane Sally in 2020, and the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE), conducted a hurricane recovery nourishment in 2022. Due to the large volume of beach compatible sand utilized from the permitted borrow areas, current work consists of an initial desk-top sand search study and a full-scale sand search study (design) and routine project monitoring. Funds requested are for monitoring. Staff have determined that 75.2% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
