Project Description
The Sunny Isles Segment - Miami-Dade County Shore Protection Project is located between DEP monuments R7 and R19.3 in Miami-Dade County. Since 1988, the 2.5 mile long segment part of the Beach Erosion Control (BEC) and Hurricane Protection Project (HP) has received periodic nourishments and numerous projects to address localized erosional hotspots. Nine additional nourishments have been completed since conception. The requested funds are for permit-required post-construction monitoring of the latest nourishment project completed by the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) in September 2021. Staff have determined that 94.62% of the project is eligible for state cost sharing.
